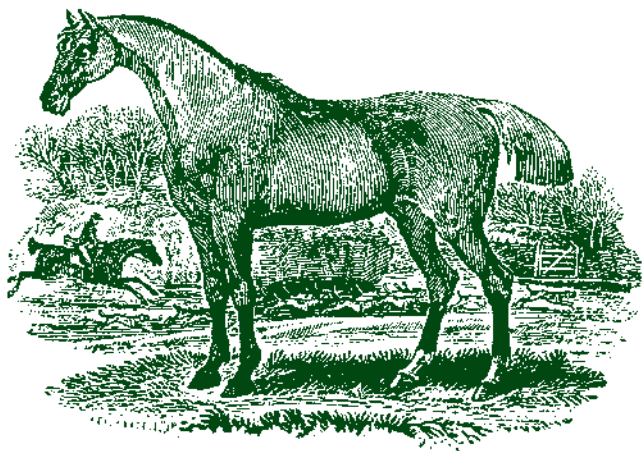

In 2003 when this day was initiated there was no Canadian Derby series and we envisioned a two round Classic. The success of the Derby series has been a shot in the arm to the hunter industry and seen owners investing in high caliber horses competing for a National title at the Royal.

I love the fact that this day has established a real legacy of giving - it is in everything you all do. Whether giving of your time and talent, your personal or business resources, from sponsorship to silent auction donations & purchases or by donating back your prize money - YOU HAVE MADE A DIFFERENCE.
