HOW YOU IMAGINE THE FUTURE OF HEADWATERS A MESSAGE FROM STACEY DAUB, CEO HHCC

Earlier this year, we launched a campaign to ask citizens in our communities to help us imagine the future of Headwaters; identify improvements that could be made at the hospital and what programs and services they see as most important for our community. As a result of more than over 40 engagements

in Dufferin County and the Town of Caledon, including focus groups, fairs and markets, and 11 municipality and township delegations, more than 1,000 community members, just like you, responded and we are listening. A number of prevailing themes emerged, including:

1. **Widespread experience of compassionate patient and family centered care;**
2. **Strong desire to expand quality health care services close to home and see more integration with community services;**
3. **Timelier access to the right care (such as emergency and diagnostic services) at the right time;**
4. **Enhanced hospital facilities.**

We will use your feedback to guide our new 2019 - 2024 Strategic Plan and to shape a shared vision for the future of Headwaters Health Care Centre. As well, we are renewing the mission and core values of the hospital, which will serve as the foundation of this planning.

Our strategic directions will focus on what is most important to our communities and represent our commitments to provide compassionate quality care, support the

changing needs of the people in the communities we serve and enhance our capacity to care for our patients close to home. We are investigating new innovative health solutions and looking beyond our hospital walls to plan for our future of care. Through this framework we will uphold a safe comfortable space, right here at Headwaters, where you can be properly supported throughout your health care journey.

YOUR DONOR DOLLARS AT WORK

It's not just a bed. It's a place patients receive their diagnosis. It's where they recover from a life changing surgery or meet their baby for the first time.

Headwaters Health Care Centre admits 5,831 patients every year to 73 beds throughout every area of the hospital. Beds are critical pieces of equipment, providing care 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. As part of ongoing capital improvements this year, 20 beds needed to be replaced and had to be funded through generous community donations.

On May 5th, 2018 the 21st Annual Gala, Headwaters Goes Hollywood was held in support of Headwaters Health Care Foundation. This event included a silent auction, raffles and the most anticipated moment of the night, the live auction. The goal at this year's live auction was to raise the money to purchase 20 hospital beds at a cost of \$10,000 per bed.

As you may know, the Ontario government does not provide funding for hospital equipment. Less than 15 minutes into the live auction, 17 beds were fully funded by generous gala-goers, raising an astounding \$170,000.

And so, thanks to thoughtful community donations, patients at Headwaters will find comfort from these new beds, which offer a supportive and therapeutic surface to optimize healing. The mattresses are designed to reduce the incidence of pressure injuries, which are recognized as an ongoing issue for patients confined to bed.



When the beds arrived at the hospital in July, Headwaters Health Care Centre staff felt like it was Christmas.

Upon arrival, the new beds were fully assembled, quality tested, tagged with identification labels, disinfected and deployed to the Medical, Surgical, and Obstetrical units.

The lifespan of most beds is 10 years, although many of those being replaced at Headwaters were much older. Headwaters' goal is to standardize its beds, allowing for enhanced staff knowledge of these beds and their advanced functions in order to support patient safety.

Thank you to our donors who made this possible, your generosity has provided comfort to every patient who turns to Headwaters hospital for their care. Together we are making Headwaters even better.

FAREWELL JOAN

As many of you may already be aware, the Foundation's Executive Director of over 10 years, Joan Burdette, will be retiring at the end of this year. Joan has been an integral part of the growth of both the hospital and foundation. She has enthusiastically and skillfully lead her team of staff and volunteers through a number of significant fundraising milestones, including the successful \$16 million Commitment to Care Campaign. This, the largest ever capital campaign undertaken in the community, saw the building of a new Ambulatory Care addition and a renovation of space allowing for a 4th operating room to be built, all while maintaining the annual fundraising needs for new capital equipment throughout the hospital.

Although we wish Joan well in this new chapter of her life, her positive spirit and friendly smiles will certainly be missed. Please join us in congratulating Joan on this occasion, and thanking her for her many years of dedicated service to our community hospital. Joan's last day will be December 21st.
