INVESTING IN A CLEARER PICTURE CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Since launching *Investing in a Clearer Picture* to improve diagnostic imaging capability at Headwaters Health Care Centre, we have many reasons to be grateful to our community. Following are some examples of equipment we received and projects that we completed due to support from you!

Our new Mammography Machine with Tomosynthesis (3D imaging) arrived allowing Headwaters to support our breast screening program and our growing number of breast cancer patients. A new C-Arm was installed at Headwaters in December which is an essential tool in displaying high-definition live videos to support our surgeons in the operating room, and lastly two new Ultrasound Machines arrived to help with quicker, safer, more accurate diagnoses.

We are now half-way to our goal of ensuring we have state-of-the-art diagnostic imaging services available for our patients. This equipment will be faster, use lower doses of radiation, and produce clearer images to ensure the best health care outcomes. To complete Investing in a Clearer Picture, we still need your help to fund the following:

New X-Ray Room (\$725,000): This room is outdated and needs to be fully replaced. The new room will include an X-Ray camera, adjustable table, technician workstations and accessories to provide quality imaging to diagnose everything from broken bones to pneumonia.

Nuclear Medicine Camera (\$600,000): This camera uses precision 3D imaging to look at specific organs to diagnose, evaluate and plan treatment for a variety of diseases.

Echocardiogram Ultrasound (\$240,000): A new ultrasound machine will allow for better imaging resolution of heart structure and support our cardiac patient needs.

We are fortunate that health care technology continuously evolves and improves to enable better care and outcomes for patients. Thank you for Investing in a Clearer Picture, to make this vison a reality at Headwaters.

CONTINUING A LEGACY OF LOVE

My father Noel was a thoughtful, caring, and independent man. He was someone you could truly count on. A loving father to me and my sister, Noel raised us in Primrose until we later moved to Toronto. He loved Caledon though, and had been living there for the past ten years to be closer to his friends and the places he

Late last year, at age 81, he had a severe right cerebral artery stroke and was rushed to Headwaters Health Care Centre.

On arrival, Dad spent time in the Emergency Department undergoing scans and tests to determine his diagnosis. Unfortunately, his stroke left him very ill and he was admitted to the hospital.

To be honest, I had never visited Headwaters much, and I wasn't sure what to expect. It didn't take long to realize we had brought Dad to the right place. I remember when he was admitted to his room, he was greeted by a nurse named Gayle whose smile was contagious and whose compassion seemed endless. Her first words to me were, "there is always something to hope for." Once I got my Dad settled, I left the Hospital feeling somewhat more confident, but with a realistic outlook, and I realized Gayle had truly helped me to understand and begin to cope with an extremely difficult situation.

The care team at Headwaters made every effort to assess what my father was capable of and what sort of recovery would be possible for him. This wasn't easy for my sister and me, and of course was a

critical time for our Dad, but we were incredibly thankful for all that Headwaters did for him. I remember a Physiotherapist named Melissa who found out what Dad's favourite music was and would sing to him – he would respond with a smile, clearly enjoying a moment of pleasure.


About a week later, he was moved to Palliative Care, and my sister and I considered moving him to Toronto because the travel back and forth was becoming tough on both of us. But based on the outstanding level of care he was receiving, moving him from Headwaters was simply not an option. We have never experienced this level of compassion and professionalism. Across the board, everyone went above and beyond. At times like this I am reminded of the importance of giving to the Foundation to ensure the patient care team at Headwaters Health Care, and the caring professionals like Gayle and Melissa, have the equipment they need to provide quality care, close to home.

Headwaters provided us with a safe space to make Dad comfortable. It allowed the end of his life to take place in comfort and dignity instead of chaos and pain. Our Dad died peacefully, a Headwaters nurse providing comfort at his side to fill his last moments with kindness and compassion.

Having witnessed first-hand the devotion to excellent, compassionate patient care that is so evident at Headwaters Health Care Centre, I truly wish to extend my heart-felt thanks. And I do hope, through generous donations from the community, that Headwaters will be there for all those who will need care for themselves and their loved ones for years to come.
